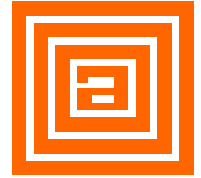

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The work included the construction of a new industrial unit for autoclaved concrete block manufacture in Catterick, North Yorkshire. Prior to commencement, the contract included the demolition of an existing industrial unit, together with the removal of asbestos.

During the course of the site investigation, on what was said to be a Roman site, extensive measures were taken in conjunction with the appropriate authorities to record and preserve the results of the archaeological excavations.

The project also included the build of a fully fitted out, detached sales office, meeting room and staff area. This included shower facilities, external stores and conveyor housings. A secondary mixing town structure and flooring including a control room and laboratory was also part of the works.
