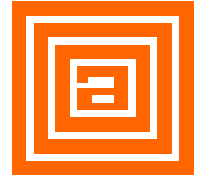

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project was the conversion of an existing church and hall into thirteen two bed flats, along with the building of two new two bedroom flats in the grounds. The works basically consisted of a three storey timber frame manufactured on-site for the flats within the church and hall and the new build being constructed traditionally.



Structural repairs were also carried out to the existing building but still retaining many existing features such as the main stained glass windows. External works included forming car parking and communal gardens. This scheme was for local people under the Section 106 local occupancy agreement, the scheme was also rated as “Good” for the Eco Homes
