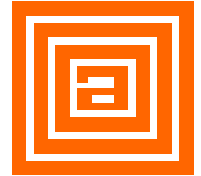


# Thomas Armstrong (Construction) Limited

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The site is situated on the existing sports field at Frenchfields, Penrith, Cumbria, with access being gained to the site from the unclassified road No 3481 leading south off the A686 Penrith to Alston road on the outskirts of Penrith.

The works comprise of the construction of a new single and part two storey traditional building. Construction is partly steel framed and partly load bearing walls on pad and strip foundations with a concrete ground floor, timber first floor and blockwork walls, rendered externally under a timber structured roof with tile covering. The total internal floor area is approximately 680 square meters and the building will be finished and fitted out to form a new sports pavilion.
