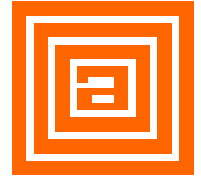

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The works comprise the alteration of the existing school buildings, including the refurbishment and relocation of classrooms. This not only upgraded the existing school but also allowed an Early Excellence Centre to be created with a first floor suite of EEC offices and adult training facilities. In order to reach the first floor, a steelwork staircase and lift have been installed which have subsequently been housed in a new brickwork and patent glazed structure.

Internally all areas have received a full installation of mechanical and electrical services and the finishes were upgraded especially in the EEC areas in order to achieve the required "WOW" factor. Externally a new car park was created, paved footpaths were installed and the fencing was upgraded and extended.

Further the existing courtyards were transformed into play areas for both the nursery and the EEC which included walkways, soft play areas, pergolas and general landscaping.
